

EDUCATION COMMITTEE

- Studies and recommends policy to the Association's Board of Directors relating to education activities for our membership, our industry, real estate specialties to professional designations.
- Studies and recommends to the Association's Board of Directors an overall education program for our membership, our industry, real estate specialties, professional designations or other target markets.
- Arranges for research pertinent to the development and improvement of specific activities within an overall educational program.
- Studies and recommends methods of financing activities within an overall education program.
- Arranges for continued review and periodic evaluation of all aspects of the education program.
- Studies and advises on establishing and conducting regular courses (live, audio, video, on-line/ computer based training, credit, non-credit, courses by specialty or tenure, "hot-topics", etc.) for specified target markets.
- Arranges for seminars, speakers, and designation courses.
- Investigates and recommends methods of conducting these courses, either by the Association(s) or in cooperation with other Associations, schools and colleges.
- Studies and recommends development of continuing education programs for members and employees of members.
- Studies and recommends establishment of educational training programs in cooperation with local, state or regional groups within the industry of profession.
- Studies and recommends sponsorship or cooperation with schools or colleges in establishing of special training courses for credit.
- Studies and investigates setting up tours for members to investigate new technology being used in the industry, etc.
- Studies and arranges for lectures or demonstrations for education the public.
